

Mentoring Artists for Women's Art (MAWA) – approved March 1, 2023.

Memorials Policy

When a former Board member, mentor, active volunteer or dedicated donor dies, MAWA writes a short obituary in the MAWA newsletter to let the community know.

If donations are made in memory of someone, either to MAWA directly or MAWA's Legacy Fund at the Winnipeg Foundation, MAWA cites the donor and the deceased in the donor section of the MAWA newsletter.

Under special circumstances, the Board may vote to name a one-time program or event in honour of a deceased member who has provided extraordinary service to the organization.

Friends and family of a MAWA member may set up a fund at the Winnipeg Foundation, the interest of which can be used to support a program that is named after the deceased. The onus for establishing and growing the funds is on the friends and family; MAWA does not fundraise for these funds. The program must be in accordance with MAWA's mandate, values and activities.
