Wendy Wersch Memorial Lecture

Policy

The Wendy Wersch Memorial Lecture Fund at the Winnipeg Foundation provides the revenue to the Wendy Wersch Memorial Lecture Committee, through MAWA, to host an annual lecture in feminist art activism, theory, criticism and practice.

The Wendy Wersch Lecture celebrates the memory of Winnipeg artist Wendy Wersch and is dedicated to exploring issues related to autonomy for women artists. The lectures focus on women in the arts as role models for innovative cultural investigation.

Procedures

The lecturer is decided upon by the Wendy Wersch Committee, which is comprised of 5-10 community members and one MAWA representative. The committee informs the Board of Directors of their selection.

The Wendy Wersch Committee organizes all aspects of the annual lecture. The monies for the event are administered through and by MAWA at no charge to the Wendy Wersch Committee.

Though the Wendy Wersch Memorial Lecture Committee operates independently of MAWA, committee members adhere to MAWA's Code of Conduct, Confidentiality, and Privacy Policies.
